adopted charter government to change its form of government within the four-year period and still qualify under paragraph, under sentence one of the (a) paragraph.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think so.

MR. SAYRE: After four-year period, you are going to have an instrument submitted to the people, is that right?

JUDGE ADKINS: Not after the four-year period you wouldn't have it submitted to the people. I assume the right of amendment would be inherent in the people, but the instrument would become effective at the end of four years if they had not previously voted on it, the charter which the General Assembly proposes.

MR. SAYRE: Then you haven't submitted to referendum?

JUDGE ADKINS: No.

MR. SAYRE: It becomes --
