I have several questions that bother me very There is no reference at all here to the continuance of powers of a charter County, one that has an existing instrument of government. You certainly mean for that to continue. I have great difficulty with the provision that the existing County governments shall have those powers provided in the Constitution. MR. CLACETT: I didn't follow the second, because I was thinking about the first. THE CHAIRMAN: The second, it seems to me you are mixing apples and oranges. In the first part of the sentence, you talk about an instrument of government, not talking about powers at all and properly so. You are concerned only with the instrument of government.
