is a County that is now a charter County, that doesn't enact an instrument of government and sits out the four years.

THE CHAIRMAN: County Commissioners will legislate.

MR. CLAGETT: They have the broad grant of power.

MRS. BOTHE: I understand, but if they have in no framework/which to exercise --

MR. CLAGETT: The Committee is firmly of the opinion, and this has been the cause espoused by Dr. Burdette from the outset, that the County Commissioners do have an adequate setup, and I am not saying structure now, but do have an adequate setup, to take care of the exercise of the broad grant of powers. However, there are other problems that enter into the picture such as I pointed up some time ago, that they could perpetuate themselves for twenty years, in office, by the exercise of those powers, so therefore, we feel, that is, the Committee feels, that the Counties and the existing County governments, including County Commissioner
