20 20 problem was and what I think Judge Adkins is trying to get at, but his solution doesn't entirely satisfy me either. As I understood your previous comment, 11.03 deals with powers.

MR. CLAGETT: Yes, sir.

That is the entire repository THE CHAIRMAN: or the source of the powers in this Constitution. 11.04 deals with the structure of County governments. but in 11.04(b) you mix the two, and my difficulty arises out of the fact that you mix the two. If 11.04(b) contented itself solely with structure, and said that existing charter County structure continues, and that until such time as any other County adopts the structure or the General Assembly plan or structure becomes effective, the existing structure of County government in that County continues, I would have no difficulty, but it is when you toss into the hopper as to the existing County governments only this question of powers that you create the confusion in my mind. Take powers out of this Section. Then you leave it solely in Section 11.03 where I think it belongs.
