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delegates. We felt that, maybe my recollection of the Committee discussion isn't accurate, but we felt that this piocess of trying to truly make it nonpartisan would be better served by this type arrangement.

We discussed this in connection with our proposed enabling act on which we are still working.

THE CHAIRMAN: Your proposal does not extend in the same system to the delegates running from the city?

MR. SCANLAN: -No, we felt there was a long tradition of Legislative districts. In a way they have come to be accorded the same dignity as a county at least for purpose of drawing election lines. We felt there was no need to tamper with that. Because that would mean if we went the other way, you would have a slate of forty-three delegates running from the City of Baltimore.

DR. BARD: Quite a number.

MR. SCANDAN: We thought that would be too
