THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Are you ready for the question? The question arises on the motion to amend Subsection (b) of Section 11.04 to read as follows: Unless and until changed, pursuant to the provisions of Section (a) hereof, County governments existing at the date of the adoption of this Constitution shall continue. All those in favor, please signify by a show of hands. Contrary. The motion is carried 17 to 1. Any further discussion of (b)?

Section (c).

MR. CLAGETT: Section (c)provides that any instrument of government of a County shall include a provision for amendment by majority vote of the voters of the County voting on such amendment, or any amendment submitted by the governing body or by petition. In other words, it provides for an amendment to be included in the instrument of government, and a referendum.

THE CHAIRMAN: This makes it mandatory that the instrument of government include this provision?

MR. CLAGETT: Yes.
