3 THE CHAIRMAN: Suppose the County in the exer-
4 cise of that power wants to decide that there shall be
5 no municipalities within its borders?

6 MR. CLAGETT: Exactly, as in Baltimore
7 County right now.

8 DR. BARD: I understand that and Howard County,
9 but the point is that you have turned over to the State
10 the whole, the broad power, and now when you are trans-
11 ferring that broad power to the County you are not trans-
12 ferring it within the same frame of reference, as I see
13 it.

14 THE CHAIRMAN: This Section isn't the transfer
15 of the power from the State to the County.

16 DR. BARD: In a sense, it is.

17 THE CHAIRMAN: No.

18 DR. BARD: 11 (e) no longer exists, isn't
19 that true, in the present Constitution?

20 MR. BROOKS: That is true.
