after the words regional representative governments, 1 the words, but excluding municipal corporations. 2 MR. CLAGETT: Mr. Chairman, I am a little 3 concerned before we leave that, by the provision in 11.05, which says that, existing municipal corporations 5 may be dissolved only by their consent, or the consent 6 of the General Assembly by law. 7 MR, SAYRE: That is where we had only by 8 creation. That is what concerned me. 9 MR. CLAGETT: If we say they can't do it, 10 11 then we say they can do it --THE CHAIRMAN: It seems to me in 11.01, you are 12 saying the General Assembly cannot by law dissolve, but 13 that is not inconsistent with consenting to dissolution 14 by County under 11.05. 15 MR. CLAGETT: Very well. If there is no in-16 consistency there --17 THE CHAIRMAN: We come back then to Dr. Bard's 18 question that the County should be compelled by man-19 datory language to provide by public local law for 20

municipal corporations.
