

1 THE CHAIRMAN: Existing municipal corpora-
2 tions?

3 DR. BARD: Yes.

4 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

6 DR. BURDETTE: I have two questions. I am not
7 sure what we are now speaking to.

8 THE CHAIRMAN: 11.05, general.
