MR. DELLA: Are you still leaving in intergovernmental authorities?

THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, but it has been moved up so that this comes before the word, regional government. Any further discussion? Are you ready for the question? The question arises on the motion to amend Section 11.01 (b) by adding the phrase, but excluding municipal corto porations,/the end. All in favor, signify by saying Aye. Contrary, No. Dr. Burdette wants to be recorded as opposing the motion.
