

1 THE CHAIRMAN: What was the question?

2 MR. HARGROVE: Does he have the power to
3 withdraw pardon once granted? Should that be in?

4 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't see how he could.
5 Wouldn't that amount in effect to a new conviction by
6 executive act?

7 MR. CASE: Sure it would.

8 MR. MILLER: It would have to be done by
9 a court on account of fraud.

10 MR. CASE: He is over the fellow's head from
11 then on.

12 MRS. BOTHE: I am a little mystified about
13 what it means, periodically notify the General Assembly.

14 JUDGE ADKINS: We intended it be left in
15 just that fashion.

16 MRS. BOTHE: The present provision to
17 advertise it in the newspaper at least has the stamp of
18 approval.

19 JUDGE ADKINS: We didn't want to spellout
20 in detail the precise method. We didn't feel that was
21 required. We felt the exercise of pardon power was
