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presented by this motion and the opposition to it the
very narrow question of whether existing municipalities
shall continue only with their existing charter powers
and no enlargement of those powers except with the con-
cept of the County or whether existing municipalities
can continue with their existing charter powers and any
other charter powers which they can obtain under the
existing charter by the amendatory process?
MR. HOFF: I don't think that goes far enough,
because I don't think that a municipality can include
anything in its charter that would permit it to annex
land adjacent to it with the protections that are now
set up under Article 23. I think that whatever we adopt,
we should adopt language that protects the Counties with
the powers given to them under Article 23; I am sorry, mun
cipalities.
