 by the County than the town of Somerset now has, that I represent, with 800 families, that was created by the State. I don't think we want the law permeated with that type of incongruity. Maybe you have a point. Maybe we are giving too much power to the County over the municipality, but I think it has to be uniform. I think you have to vote it up one way or another, up or down.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Are you ready for the question? The question arises on the amendment to the second sentence of Section 11.05, to provide that it shall read as follows: No existing municipal corporation may be dissolved or be subject to the withdrawal of any existing powers set forth in its charter without either the consent of the governing body or the consent of the General Assembly. A vote Aye is a vote in favor of the sentence as amended. All in favor, please signify by a show of hands.
