1 you correctly, the State could add additional agreements, 2 but it couldn't abstract from these agreements, could it? 3 MR. CLAGETT: It couldn't subtract from the agreement. The protection of the contract would take care of that, if there was an agreement. 5 6 DR. BURDETTE: That is the danger that the 7 Chairman is speaking about. ន THE CHAIRMAN: What I am supposing is that 9 if a Constitution says nothing in this Constitution shall 10 prevent me from agreeing with Dr. Burdette that the 11 sun is shining, that is tantamount to saying that he and 12 I shall have the authority to make such an agreement. 13 MR. CLACETT: Let me ask you this. Where is 14 there anything in the Constitution that does prohibit 15 the cooperation of Prince Georges County with the District 16 of Columbia? 17 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't know that there is. 18 I am content to leave it that way, but I don't want to 19 create a situation that gives a constitutional blessing
