a time. I don't think this is the moment to ask us to pass judgment on something like that, that important.

MR. CLAGETT: It is in writing if you will refer to the Fifth Report, and Page 7 of that Fifth Report; preliminary draft, not for publication, Fifth Report.

DR. BARD: It isn't on the agenda for today.

MR. CLAGETT: I am caught by that one.

DR. BARD: I was not prepared. I think this is too important a concept to set forth for a vote at this hour.

MR. CLAGETT: Would you want to table it? I have made the motion. In fact, I feel that it is -- I am very much persuaded by the presentation of Dean Fordham, and I can't recall the name of the person that appeared at the very early meetings of the Commission but his comments will appear of record in the minutes of that meeting or the transcript. I am very much persuaded by the argument that was then given to us, that this would be a very helpful clause in stimulating cooperative effort between States and the units as defined, subdivisions
