the Counties shall do this, that or the other, provide
this or that or the other advice?

MR. CLAGETT: All they have to do is pay for

it.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is just the point. It
might be a local service, that the State may say that

the Counties should provide, and be akin to, but different from Boards of Education, and yet this would be
putting in as a matter of constitutional prohibition
any right of the Legislature to require the Counties

generally to do such a thing.

MRS. FREEDLANDER: A point of order,

Mr. Chairman. Didn't we approve of this at some previous

time, this provision?

MR. BROOKS: This was a part of the Second

Report of this Committee.

MRS. FREEDLANDER: I thought the Commission
