I might say that there has been apparently a great deal of conversation back and forth among members of the Legislature, both old members and newly elected members, on this question, anyhow. In any event, we are going ahead with these conferences with the leaders I have indicated.

In addition, we discussed the question at some length with Senator Tydings. I hope to have a similar discussion with Senator Brewster and, at the suggestion of the people we have talked to, hope soon to have a discussion with the incoming Executive of Ealtimore County, Dale Anderson.

These discussions, I might say, are not at all to persuade the people we are talking to to any particular view. Indeed, one of the problems is that we are unable to do this. We can't say the Commission is definitely going to recommend this or that. The sole purpose is to make them alive to the problem, because what we do hope to do is to have a bill sponsored by this Commission introduced in the opening days of the Legislature and we would hope that it would be acted on
