and others, sheriffs and state's attorneys, and so forth, because their terms are just beginning in November, 66, or December, '66, would have expired by that time.

However, that is a major policy decision for the Commission, whether it would be politic to defer the effective date of the judiciary article from 1968 until the end of 1970.

Similar decisions will have to be made with reference to other articles, particularly as to preserving the pension rights and salary rights of elected officers in every branch of the government. Accordingly, what we will try to do is to get the whole Constitution circulated to you and then the staff will try to get up some suggestions as to a schedule and circulate that among the Commission members as the basis for our discussion.

Only one other thing, I think, we need mention in connection with the schedule and that is that we have been assuming, I think, many times in our discussions that the schedule would be not only a temporary thing, that would not continue to be printed
