the field and to form district-wide or county-wide organizations to back particular candidates. Some of you may have heard of one such group which started in the past ten days, which was really a whirlwind effort, the phone rang all one morning, people called about this, a group called Civic.

Many of the relephone calls indicated that this is a group sponsored by Dr. Eisenhower, President of Hopkins. That is a little bit of an exaggeration, I think. The sponsors of the group are two young men very much interested. One is Dr. Eisenhower's administrative assistant, Walt and the other is George Wills and their motive, at best, they are trying to get a group together that could solidify the efforts of all civil groups and get away from the problem of hwing a scattering of votes for the highly qualified people.

Part of the problem which many of the people have suggested to us in this area is that if various civil groups become interested, it's going to be awfully difficult to get them to unite and combine on a slate for any particlar county. For instance, to use Baltimore
