me great concern about certain facets and the judges
talk to the lawyers and the lawyers talk to the
politicians and this thing, you just can't put it in a
vacuum and say we are going to have great people and
fine people going ahead with a great Constitution, and I
hope it will be a great Constitution, but we can't live
in a vacuum.

I don't feel this affects Baltimore County alone. Of course, since Mr. Eney's talk, I see I have very good company, so far as the Governor agreeing. It isn't Baltimore County. Baltimore County is one I happen to be familiar with, but it's all the urban areas. As I say, as long as this convention is going to have the issue before it that it's going to have in affecting the millions of dollars it's going to affect and the people it's going to affect, I don't feel we can do much more than try tomake the nomination of delegates as close to the people as possible and I think that's by districts. I don't personally feel that a blue ribbon panel of nominating commissioners may get through the Legislature.
