working with the different groups trying to get the right kind of people to run and support the right kind of people.

I feel we're in a position right now that

I think we have to recognize the change of climate in

political affairs at least that have come over the last

few years and that the only real concrete constructive

move will be to follow along with the same procedure

used in the last election, where people will be elected

from the representative districts and the subdivisions

in which they live. This way you are going to have

the election made by the people in those areas. The

selection of the people will be made by the people in

those areas and not by some group that is going to control

the county or the state as a whole.

THE CHAIRMAN: Dr. Templeton.

DR. TEMPLETON: A question, Mr. Chairman.

So far, the discussion has centered solely on Baltimore

County. Has there been any flak received from any other

regions or counties throughout the state?

THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, but not to the extent
