can try to exercise some control.

THE CHAIRMAN: I should have mentioned that there has been some indication that that same group might be interested in activating itself to have a slate of candidates or to support candidates here. Dr. Jenkins?

DR. JENKINS: Mr. Chairman, what is the parliamentary situation? I was under the impression we were having a preliminary debate prior to a vote on reconsideration of something, and now I understand that this is just an informal discussion leading to another vote. I'm sure you are more frustrated than I or any other member of the Commission by the interminable but apparently necessary debate and discussion about every point.

Knowing this Commission, I'm certain that if this is put over to the 19th, all of these arguments will be re-presented in order to refresh our minds, although most of us are pretty certain of how we're going to vote on this particular issue. What is before the
