necessary to take a vote on this day that we could not do 1 so because, of course, we could. At some point which 2 hasn't yet occurred, I anticipate there will be a motion 3 to reconsider the action of the Commission in approving the recommendation of the Committee on Convention 5 Procedures that the election of delegates be by districts 6 in Baltimore City and by counties elsewhere. 7 DR. JENKINS: I don't think that quite 8 clarifies my thinking. At some point, not now, but 9 10 later --THE CHAIRMAN: No one as yet has made such 11 12 a motion. DR. JENKINS: My feeling is we should 13 go on and dispose of this and go back to trying to get 14 some of these items in the discussion. 15 THE CHAIRMAN: Well, Mr. Scanlan has 16 indicated the Commission's point of view and he obviously 17 does not intend to make such a motion. Does anyone move --18 DR. BARD: I would like to make such a 19 motion, I had my hand up for some time, but I don't know 20 whether it's in order. At any rate, I'd like to speak
