THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Sayre?

MR. SAYRE: I think we have to have the pros and cons on all these points a little more succinctly marshalled and we might give more consideration to the ides of a convention in each County, or something, but here you have problems: will you have separate conventions for Republicans and Democrats or one big convention where all civic groups could be present, or where do you draw the line? Do you have civic associations, medical and dental, various organizations, and there is no limit where you can go and also, if you did have a convention, there ought to be some sort of rules that would be submitted in advance. and I just think you have to have reasons why you would rule this out, so when we do make a recommendation, the legislature will consider it very favorably, in view of all the other data we have.
