first assignment, was it possible to work out a nominating 1 procedure or some other device to limit the candidates. 2 On that, I speak for the Committee, it would be useless to 3 refer that back. The second referral, as I understand it, was if 5 there was some break point we could put on the districts. 6 I suppose we could reconsider that, but my own personal 7 feeling is, with the possible exception of the compromise
