we know what the legislature is going to do, we don't know what to recommend?

THE CHAIRMAN: Maybe. Mr. Case?

MR. CASE: I disagree with the congressman. I think that this Commission, which has gained an amount of prestige throughout the State, ought to bring that prestige to bear through the press and otherwise to urge people to combine, just as you say this Hopkins group is doing. I think that is a very good idea, and I think we ought to urge in a press release, yes, I think a press release, with the business about what we decide today, that people ought to combine to select, for the purpose of selecting the very best candidates possible to this Convention.

Now, how they combine and what they do and how they make the selections of slates obviously should be left up to them and we shouldn't in any way attempt to dictate that, but I think that you've got to have leadership from some place. If the leadership doesn't come from this Commission, it is going to be like the fellow who got on his horse and rode off in all directions. You're just not going to have any leadership, and that is exactly what is
