point or steering committee for the other groups, and 1 secondly, when we see Governor Elect Agnew, whether we should suggest this to him and have him recommend the 3 committee. I would like to not make a motion MR. CLAGETT: 5 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think we need a motion. 6 7 MR. CLAGETT: I say I would like not to make 8 a motion and urge that point of view, and I would like to 9 make another comment. I don't see too much difference in the views of Congressman Miller and Dick Case. 10 11 it's merely one in detail. 12 MR. CASE: In answer to that, let me say there 13 is no difference between the congressman and me in this 14 suggestion, because I think it would be wrong for this 15 Committee to have a subcommittee or group of it to do 16 this coordinating.
