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connection and get the ball rolling. Once you get this ball rolling, and with the kind of press coverage it's going to get, it will roll. It's just a question of kicking it off, but I don't think it ought to be Judge Gray's group because that is associated with this Commission.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

MR. SCANLAN: Also, I think the new governor should have the opportunity, if it is going to be a new Citizens' Committee, I think it unfair to perhaps saddle the new governor with the Gray Commission, unless he wanted it that way. I think he should be given the opportunity to express his views on the merits of such a Citizens' Committee, and how it is to be formed. Generally, I favor it, however.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

MR. BOND: I don't mean to belabor this, Mr.

Chairman, but I do feel our primary responsibility is to
have a good Constitution in the hands of the Convention
and we should -- we all want good delegates, but we've
got to get a good product in and, if we have a good product,
we don't want to taint it by getting out too much in the
