neglected or refused to take the oath. We feel it is superfluous and unnecessary to have this provision either in the Constitution or in the statutory law and we therefore recommend its removal.

Shall I move on or shall we --

THE CHAIRMAN: We will follow the procedure and ask if anyone has a question or comment and, in the absence of a motion to the contrary, the recommendation of the Committee would be considered as having been approved. Are there any questions as to this particular provision? Any comments?

I have one question and I don't know that it is answerable. Is there any indication as to when the office becomes vacant in the event of a failure to take the oath?

MRS. BOTHE: We're going to consider, I believe, a few sections down, a provision which does state manner of qualifying for office and we recommend its deletion as well. So, I suppose the hiatus will be lengthened if we adopt that. No, there isn't, but I believe, without having read the cases cited here, that there is an implicit -- that if without having qualified within a reasonable
