process compliance that exists when such a law happens.

Of course, an indeterminate sentence law is something of a departure from standard legislation, because traditionally the legislature says that a pick-pocketing shall be an offense and the minimum penalty would be six months and the maximum two years. When they say that being a defective delinquent will subject you to an indeterminate sentence, this is quite a departure from traditional legislating and, for that reason, we had great hesitancy in not leaving the constitutional authority to do it in the books, but it seems quite unnecessary.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further question or comment? Mr. Sayre?

Under the rule making power section of the judiciary article, would it not be understood that the Court by rule would have the power on indeterminate sentencing to suspend, or whatever, if not provided by law through the General Assembly?
