believe the Courts rule making powers would be the source 1 of suspending sentences or parole, but that it would be 2 essentially either legislative or within the inherent power 3 of the Court. MR. SAYRE: This does not enter into the practice 5 and procedure --6 THE CHAIRMAN: I don't think so. I think the 7 rule making power might extend to procedures to be followed 8 by the Court in suspending a sentence, but not as to the 9 powers of the Court. 10 MR. SAYRE: So, this would be a legislative matter 11 12 altogether? MRS. BOTHE: And also would rest within the 13 inherent power of the Court to some degree to suspend 14 sentences or grant parole, but this isn't in an area that 15 would be affected by the deletion or retention of this 16 17 section. THE CHAIRMAN: Mr. Martineau? 18 MR. MARTINEAU: I think the Committee ought to 19 be commended on its choice of consultants from the academic 20 21 community.
