THE CHAIRMAN: Can we come to order? Lest I 1. forget it later on, it was suggested at dinner, and thought 2 by your Chairman, that 9:30 was much too early an hour of 3 adjournment and that we might continue on. We will see how 4 it goes and how tired you are when we get there. 5 I would like to get well into the Legislative 6 Department report before we move on. 7 We are ready now for the Fourth Report of the 8 Committee on Elective Franchise and Declaration of Rights, 9 10 Jim Gentry. MR. MINDEL: May I have a minute of the time 11 of the Commission, please, Mr. Chairman? 12 Now that everybody has enjoyed the hospitality 13 of the Congressman, I would like to call you attention to 14 something that has been turned over to me. 1 have before me 15 a Xerox copy of a proposed new Constitution, which was 16 published in the Sun on April 12, 1937. It was written by 17 our late friend Henry L. Mencken, and it was with a/deal of 18 interest that I have listened to all of the discussion 19 this afternoon. I thought you would bear with me for just 20

a few minutes to let me tell you of some of the things that
