

1 MR. MILLER: Thank you so much. You don't
2 know how much I appreciate your company.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: I think we will adopt that in
4 a rising vote of thanks.

5 MR. MILLER: I hope you will do it again.

6 MR. GENTRY: This first section of this Fourth
7 Report deals with changes which are, I trust and hope,
8 merely re-editing of sections which have been previously
9 presented, and the first three sections have been
10 previously adopted. They deal with general eligibility
11 of voting. They deal with voting in presidential
12 elections and we move now to Section 4, which is disquali-
13 fication from voting.

14 Previously, we had disqualification pegged
15 to mental adjudication.

16 MR. MILES: May I ask a question?

17 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes.

18 MR. MILES: To define districts. Is there
19 any conflict between this and the Legislative Committee?
