We are still on Section 4. MR. GENTRY: disqualification. Disqualification, previously we had pegged to adjudication of mental incompetency and conviction of such crimes as the Legislature should designate. It was felt at the last meeting that the word adjudication should be stricken, because there are many cases of mental incompetency where there has been no mental adjudication, and therefore this current submission eliminates the word adjudication, and adds, the last sentence, any person excluded from voting for conviction of a crime shall again be eligible to vote if pardoned by the Governor.

That was not in the first submission and that is added to take care of the situation where a man, because of reformation or because of any reason which the Governor deems appropriate should be again given his franchise rights.
