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MR. GENTRY: That is right. Many persons in institutions are not there by official court adjudication.

MR. MILLER: Don't you think you should define that a little bit? The only reason I say this, my own Congressional leader said he could always know how he was doing in an election by the way the insane asylum acted. If he went through there and they said hello Joe, he knew he was in. Shouldn't we say mentally incompetent, with some definition?

MR. GENTRY: We had the words at the last

mentally adjudicated, mentally incompetence. The Commission felt that was too severe a test because of the many persons who were in institutions, there by certification to doctors, which did not amount to an official adjudication.

MR. MILLER: You have opened the door. You haven't said official adjudication. I think if you stick with the law, you are all right.
