MR. MILLER: I think this: I know that you should have election contests and whatnot, if part of it is in and the rest isn't."

MRS. BOTHE: I think it should be amended to say, as defined by law, after mentally incompetent or in some way to restrict it.

THE CHAIRMAN: Granting for the moment that, in Section 5, which is where I think it would be that I would clarify it to make it unquestionably covered; that wouldn't meet Mr. Miller's point.

MR. GENTRY: Of course, by the strict way of defining it, it would be to leave it as we originally submitted it, adjudicated mentally incompetent but we appreciated the question which was raised at the last meeting, that an adjudication was something which went much further than is the case with regard to many persons who are in institutions by certification of two doctors and are not there by reason of a court adjudication.
