this thought of the Committee. Actually we have been discussing this in connection with the proposed enabling act, the test of which we hope to lay before this Commission at your next meeting.

I would, if my Committee doesn't feel I am departing from my instructions, at this time I think it would be sufficient if our recommendation was that the delegates to the convention would have to be twenty-one years of age, have resided in Maryland at least three years, the last year thereof in the district or county from which he runs prior to the time of his election, with the understanding that we will have a more concrete recommendation on the question of whether the subdistricting that we now have in connection with the House of Delegates, and for that matter, the State Senate, should be followed in the election of delegates to the convention. Do I make myself clear?
