THE CHAIRMAN: Any further comment or discussion? Are you ready for the question?

DR. BURDETTE: What is the question?

THE CHAIRMAN: A vote aye will mean that

you are in favor of a provision in the Constitution declaring that a person who is mentally incompetent is ineligible to vote, but specifically leaving to the Legislature to determine by law a method and manner of ascertaining mental incompetency and the standards for determining mental incompetency.

MRS. BOTHE: To vote?

THE CHAIRMAN: To vote. A vote no is simply you don't approve that method. We will go to something else.

DR. BURDETTE: Will you tell me how to vote
