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area, you will get a truly representative group.

MR. CLAGETT: The difficulty is you pass over some of your best qualified people.

THE CHAIRMAN: What do you mean when you say pass; over?

MR. CLAGETT: By reason of the fact some of your best qualified people may not be located in that particular district. By restricting it to the district, you are going to eliminate people that may have better qualify ations than those chosen as representatives by reason of that restriction.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion?

MR. MILES: If you shift it to the State Senatorial partern rather than the House pattern, you would have some counties that didn't have any delegates which I think would be very unfortunate.

MR. DELLA: This would be based on the representation in the House.

MR. MILES: Somebody suggested shifting it to the Senatorial pattern.
