

1 to develop a uniform procedure for elections and voting
2 rights and at the same time give local subdivisions the
3 right to change this type of procedure. It seems to
4 me that if a person is going to be eligible to vote in
5 a state election or a national election and just be-
6 cause he doesn't have any property but maybe rent and
7 is still old enough to vote and work and such as that,
8 that he is not going to be allowed to vote in any
9 municipal election because he doesn't own a house or
10 piece of ground, this seems to me is taking away the
11 rights of this individual to vote.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: This was gone into at great
13 length at the last meeting and I don't want to repeat
14 it all. Do you want to summarize it, Judge Adkins?
15 You were one of the spokesmen.

16 JUDGE ADKINS: I think the thing that is
17 not the point Mr. Della suggests, I am not for attach-
18 ing a property qualification. I don't know of any
19 administration in this state which requires a property
20 requirement to vote if there is a residency qualification.
