our recommendation does not foreclose the final Commission recommendation on this controversial point whether they should run from subdistricts or counties at large.

THE CHAIRMAN: That is right, as you amended the recommendation.

MR. SAYRE: Every one of these considerations brought up were considered by the Committee. Probably a couple of others also. But the crux of the problem was really the idea that now would you gain the best representation, the best quality and ability, from a locality, and it was felt that in a county where you would have natural accommodations being made just in anticipation of the event that that was perhaps the best way to get delegates.

I am just wondering if that doesn't seem to be something acknowledged, that there would be accommodations forthcoming, if we could gain a consensus or just a feeling on this point and then go ahead.

MR. SCANLAN: They are going to get a crack at it in our proposed enabling act. We have to do it one way or another in that draft and they can vote it

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
