2 as to nominations.

3 MR. GENTRY: It doesn't provide that. It
4 does provide that. It does provide the General Assembly
5 determines it rather than county charter.

6 JUDGE ADKINS: It says nomination of candi-
7 dates.

8 MR. SAYRE: We are talking about voters.

9 MR. HAILE: Mr. Chairman, earlier today we
10 adopted the language that the Governor shall be
11 elected at the general election every other even numbered
12 year and I considered that Section 5 deals with general
13 elections, and I submit that if we call it general
14 elections, it will clarify this whole matter. This
15 governs general elections. Then when local subdivisions
16 choose, they may have their officials run in the same
17 manner as officials would run in general elections.

18 THE CHAIRMAN: Do you consider the county
19 elections general elections also?

20 MR. HAILE: Operated as they are in Baltimore
21 County, they are part of the general elections, on the
