2 MR. CASE: Unless you want to restrict Dale's
3 point to municipalities; Section 11 (e).

4 JUDGE ADKINS: Insofar as qualification of
5 voters, I would agree, but insofar as registration of
6 voters is concerned, I would agree with Dick Case it
7 can be limited to municipalities; insofar as nomination
8 of candidates is concerned, I don't think it can be
9 limited to municipalities. I think you have varying
10 methods of nomination of candidates within the state
11 by virtue of local home rule.

12 MR. SAYRE: We are talking about voters.

13 JUDGE ADKINS: I am being forced to the
14 conclusion that we have got to have two sections, although
15 I was the one that suggested we eliminate Section 7.
16 I am being forced to a conclusion that we are going to
17 have to have two sections.

18 MR. CLAGETT: Certainly it clarifies the
19 situation. The only alternative would be to have a
20 very strongly worded provision in the local government
21 section, such as you suggested earlier, but as I say,
