10 MR. SAYRE: I would say municipal corpora-
11 tions as defined by law.

12 THE CHAIRMAN: His point, I think, Mr. Case,
13 was that you might have a super-county something
14 between the county and the state, an aggregation of
15 counties.

16 MR. SAYRE: You can have a public corporation.

17 MR. CASE: A county is a municipal corporation.

18 MR. SAYRE: That is right.
