

up or down. They are acquainted with the problem.

THE CHAIRMAN: I think the discussion has been general enough that you can get the consensus by reading the report to the extent you would get it in a vote at this time.

DR. BARD: The only thing I was going to say was we tied in their numbers and the whole concept with the new arrangement in the House of Delegates. I think there is some merit in actually filling it in terms of the district arrangement which was tied in with the 142.

THE CHAIRMAN: Any further discussion? Ready for the question? Question will be on the approval of the recommendation as amended. That is, that qualifications of the delegates to the constitutional convention be that he be at least twenty-one years of age, have resided in Maryland for at least three years, and at least the last year prior to the time of his election have resided either in the county or in the subdistrict thereof from which he runs. This latter question being specifically reserved for future Commission action.
