7 devil's advocate at this point. I am not sure. Certainly
8 I feel it would be a chaotic situation throughout the
9 state to have certain municipalities in municipal
10 elections allowing people 18, others 19, others 20,
11 others 21 in different areas throughout the state and
12 I think there should be a uniform minimum age.

13 THE CHAIRMAN: Anything further?

14 Mr. Gentry?

15 MR. GENTRY: Except that this is the exact
16 proposition which was presented at the last meeting,
17 and voted to preserve age 21, preserve the integrity
18 across the board and everything else was left open.

19 MR. SAYRE: Mr. Chairman, I move a substitute
20 motion, that we have age 19 as the uniform provision for
21 all elections throughout the state.
