2 within the Constitution itself.

3 THE CHAIRMAN: Yes, but I wanted to make
4 it clear that Mr. Miles' motion that the qualifications
5 be residence or property did not carry with it the im-
6 plication that residence meant residence on Federal
7 reservations.

8 MR. MILES: That is correct.

9 THE CHAIRMAN: Is there any further discus-
10 sion of the motion? Are you ready for the question?

11 MR. CASE: Would somebody state the motion?

12 MR. MILES: With respect to municipalities
13 and excluding Federal reservations, if that is necessary,
14 that a person be qualified to vote in a municipality,
15 not a Federal reservation, if he is either a resident
16 or property owner but that his right to vote shall not
17 be abridged for any other reason.

18 MR. CASE: He has to be 21 or above.

19 MR. MILES: Yes.

20 MR. CASE: 21 or above.

21 THE CHAIRMAN: Not convicted; not mental.
