2 MR. MILES: What we are saying is he has to
3 be 21 years old wherever he votes, city, county, state,
4 anywhere else; municipalities, he may impose a provision
5 that a person is qualified to vote if he is either a
6 resident or a property owner, but that his right shall
7 not be abridged for any other reason.

8 MR. CASE: May I ask one further question?
9 This then really is almost a complete reversal of this
10 Section 7, the philosophy of Section 7 being that, as
11 I understood it, I wasn't at the last meeting when this
12 was discussed, but it is my understanding from what I
13 have heard here that the Commission decided that the
14 municipalities should be fairly free in fixing quali-
15 fications for voting in municipal elections to protect
16 the integrity of the community, and I take it from what
17 you are suggesting now that that be turned around and
18 that it be put in the positive form, that the only
19 things they can use are age, that being 21, residency
20 or property.

21 MR. MILES: Or property.
