

1 THE CHAIRMAN: As I understand the results of
2 what we have done in the past hour or so, I suppose,
3 with respect to statewide elections and county elections,
4 other than pertaining to nomination of candidates in
5 county elections, Section 5, or the principle of Section
6 5 will control. With respect to nomination of candidates
7 in county elections, the provisions of the charter of
8 the county may control. With respect to municipal
9 elections, the provisions of Section 4, generally will
10 control, except that the municipality can increase the
11 minimum voting age, but cannot reduce it below the age
12 of 21 years and except that they can extend to nonresident
13 property owners the elective franchise.

14 I think that is the substance of what
15 we have done in the past hour or so.

16 MR. CASE: And define property owners by
17 saying you have to have at least a hundred dollars or
18 five thousand dollars or so, is that implicit?

19 THE CHAIRMAN: I would think so. Now,
20 Professor Asper and Mr. Gentry, do you think you have a
21 clear understanding of what the Commission would like to
