2 MR. CASE: Any further question, Dr. Bard?

3 DR. BARD: I have a comment. I will make
4 it later.

5 THE CHAIRMAN: Go ahead. You have the
6 floor now.

7 DR. BARD: I must say I am not sold on the
8 matter of the initiative myself. I have a feeling that
9 there is as much danger in it as there is possible value.
10 You can get a small group of people together to push
11 through some idea that can be quite harmful that will
12 not be given the thought. I am not referring to an
13 initiative based -- I am not referring to a referendum
14 based on something that has been passed by the Legisla-
15 ture. This is taken care of later on, is it not?

16 MR. SAYRE: Yes.

17 DR. BARD: I am referring to the type of
18 initiative you have in mind. I believe Maryland Legis-
19 lature does not have at present such initiative.

20 MR. CASE: That is correct.
